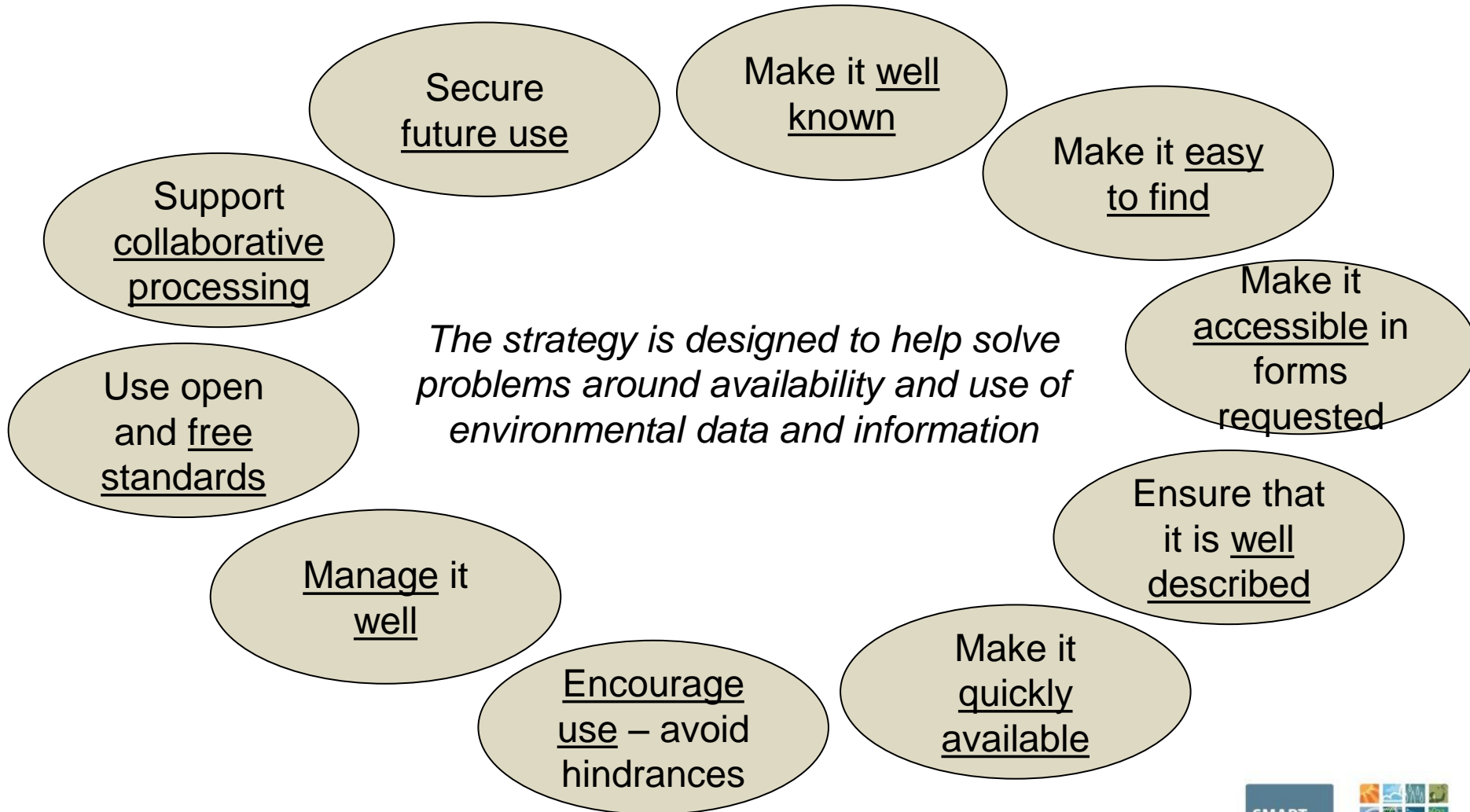


Well managed environmental data is of significant benefit and makes a difference for the environment

Recommendations (28)

1. Make environmental data well known
2. Make environmental data easy to find

Recommendations guideline 2:

- *Make data and digital services as well as their descriptions (metadata) searchable on the Web. Both through conventional search engines and directories with descriptions of the data and services as well as through encyclopedias such as Wikipedia*
- *Follow the E-delegation's recommendation of a public list of the organization's data*

4. Ensure environmental data is available in digital format
