- Realization and implementation of the projects

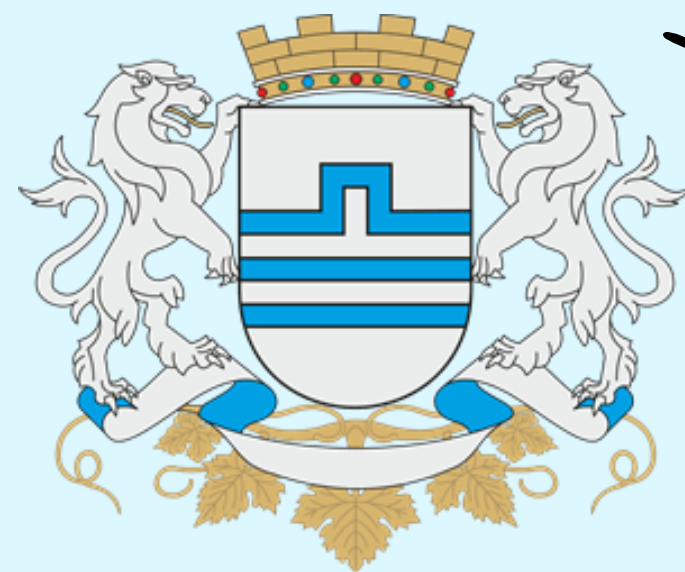


# PROJECTS

- Podgorica – promotion of the use of public transport among peers
- Niksic – construction of a green bus stop
- Plav – environmental activities aimed at improving the awareness of fellow citizens regarding illegal waste disposal, as well as improving communal infrastructure

- Talked with people that are currently working on the *Partnership for Improving Air Quality in the Western Balkans*



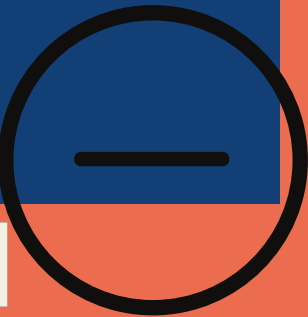
# POSITIVE AND NEGATIVE SIDES
