## **Consultation in accordance with Articles 4 and 5 of the Espoo Convention on Environmental Impact Assessment in a Transboundary Context (Espoo Convention) for the Jammerland Bugt Wind development project**

In a letter dated 10/11/2021, Denmark notified your country, in accordance with Article 3 of the Espoo Convention, of the Jammerland Bugt offshore wind project development European Energy A/S. The operator has applied to pre-investigate and develop for the construction and operation of a 240 MW windfarm in bay of Jammerland (Jammerland Bugt).

The projects are a development project to construct and operate 16 turbines in the Jammerland bay. The project EIA covers an assessment of 3 scenarios with various turbines and position and the related environmental impact. Note that the final project will consist of the scenario with 16 turbines 256 meter to tip height.

The developer, Jammerland Bay Nearshore A/S owned by European Energy A/S, has now prepared an environmental impact assessment, where the previously agreed chapters with appendices have been translated. Denmark hereby – in accordance with the provisions of the Espoo Convention – sends the assessment documentation to you in order to give you the opportunity for consultations and public participation (Articles 4 and 5). The Espoo EIA reports and appendices describing the project-related transboundary impacts potentially affecting the marine territories of neighboring countries will be at your disposal in German, and the very specialized appendices in English. A Danish version of the project EIA have been prepared and approved by the Danish Authorities. Denmark kindly asks you to submit your comments no later than **May 29 2024** and to:

- indicate preferably already before 01.05 2024 if you see a need for additional consultations.
