Information to EU ETS shipping companies about published guidance documents (GD1 and GD2)

Kommissionen antog den 4 juli 2024 två vägledningsdokument för att stödja implementeringen av ETS-direktivet 2003/87/EG och EU MRV-förordningen (EU) 2015/757 för sjöfarten. Dessa har publicerats på sidan [Reducing emissions from the shipping sector - European Commission \(europa.eu\)](https://ec.europa.eu/eu-ets/transport/shipping).

Det första vägledningsdokumentet (GD1) riktar sig primärt till rederier. I dokumentet finns bland annat information om övervakningsplaner och hållbara biobränslen.

Det andra vägledningsdokumentet (GD2) riktar sig till de administrerande myndigheterna (däribland Naturvårdsverket) och syftar till att ge vägledning vid granskningen av övervakningsplanerna.

On 4 July 2024 the European Commission adopted two guidance documents to support the implementation of the EU ETS Directive 2003/87/EG and EU MRV Regulation (EU) 2015/757 for the maritime sector. These have been published on the following website [Reducing emissions from the shipping sector - European Commission \(europa.eu\)](https://ec.europa.eu/eu-ets/transport/shipping).

The first guidance document (GD1) is primarily addressed to shipping companies. It includes among other things information on monitoring plans and sustainable biofuels.

The second guidance document (GD2) is addressed to administering authorities (including the Swedish EPA) providing general guidance on the process for approval of monitoring plans by administering authorities.
