Danish wind farms in Jammerland Bay and Omoe South within Danish territorial water in the Great Belt – Notification and consultation pursuant to Article 7 of Directive 2011/92/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 13 December 2011 on the assessment of the effects of certain public and private projects on the environment and Article 3 og 4 of the Convention on Environmental Impact Assessment in a Transboundary Context

A private developer “Omoe South Nearshore A/S” is planning a wind farm with a capacity of max. 320 MW consisting of 25-80 turbines immediately south of the island Omoe in the Great Belt. At the same time the developer “Jammerland Bay Nearshore A/S” is planning a wind farm with the capacity of max. 240 MW (34-80 turbines) in the bay of Jammerland Bay also located in the Great Belt.

There have been prepared EIA reports for both projects. The EIAs and the background reports for Jammerland Bay can be requested at the Danish Energy Agency. An English summary of the potentially transboundary environmental impact is enclosed.
