Youth engagement for Air Quality in Albania

April 26, 2023







Children and young people have a higher breathing rate and a higher body/surface ratio, thus they breathe in more pollution; they also have less developed natural protective barriers against inhaled particles.

What data and **YOUTH** are saying:

An **e-questionnaire "Air quality around me!"** was launched through the U-Report platform in November 2022:

Target: 214 responders out of which **61%** were young people in the age range **15- 24** years old.

- Two key data from this poll were:
- **81 %** of respondents believe that Climate change and air pollution problems are intertwined
- **83%** of respondents feel that air quality in their cities has deteriorated since they were children.

What **YOUTH** in Albania want:





• A Youth Manifesto with concrete demands and contribution by YOUTH on:

1) Reduction of Deforestation,

2) Preservation of water resources,

3) Green Public transportation and

4) Prevention of Air pollution itself.

What YOUTH from Albania will do for improving Air Quality:

#Advocate:

- Digital communication campaign with key messages, youth influencers on raising awareness on air quality.
- Watchdog skills for 250 young advocates in the municipalities of Fier, Kurbin, Durres and Korçë;
- Air&Climate Hub exchange meeting with 50 youth from municipalities of Fier, Kurbin, Durres, Korçë, Tirana, Shkodra, Elbasan, Pogradec, Berat;
- Youth led designed initiative on air quality and five youth led position papers;
- Three Peer-to-peer learning events for young people;
- Nine municipal meetings for advocacy purposed between youth and municipal stakeholders to advocate for the implementation of initiatives in municipal action plans focusing on environmental aspects/ air quality.
