ESPOO Notification of the revision of the German MSP and SEA process - Comments from Sweden

Sweden have in an earlier e-mail acknowledge the receipt of the notification and confirmed that Sweden wishes to participate in the consultation procedure.

The Swedish Environmental Protection Agency (SEPA) will with this reply inform about the consultation process in Sweden. SEPA distributed the 2 April 2020 the informal notification to national authorities, country administrative boards, marine organizations and NGO:s and to research centers and asked for comments no later than 17 April. SEPA also displayed the notification and the documents on the webpage.

Due to the short period for comments, few answer with comments are received.

The Swedish National Heritage Board, the Geological Survey of Sweden, the Swedish Coast Guard, Swedish Armed Forces, the Swedish Defence Research Agency and the Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences have all replied that they abstain from commenting or have no comments.

Comments have been received from The Swedish Transport Administration, The Swedish Agency for Marine and Water Management, the County Administrative Board of Skåne and the County Administrative Board of Blekinge, enclosure in this e-mail.

The statements from the County Administrative Board of Skåne is written in Swedish and have been translated on courtesy and is attached as a non-official translation.
